
Terms & Conditions 2024/25

1 - Refundable Deposit

- It's important to note that the full refundable deposit is due at the time of acceptance of a seat at Aster International School Bangkok to secure the seat.
- The refundable deposit will be refunded under the following conditions
 1. Only once the student has been enrolled for a minimum of one full term
 2. When a 60-day notice of withdrawal is given
 3. Graduation from Aster International School Bangkok at the end of Year 13

2 - Tuition Fees & General Fees

- Tuition fees and General Fees are published on the school website for the current school year. They are subject to change annually, and families will be notified of any changes before the first invoice for the next school year.
- Invoices are issued three times a year, one for each term. If you would prefer a yearly invoice, please contact our team at accounts@aster.ac.th
- All tuition fees and general fees must be paid by the due date on each invoice.

3 - Non-Payment of Tuition Fees & General Fees

- If there is likely to be a late or missed payment, please contact our team at accounts@aster.ac.th immediately so we can make necessary arrangements and support plans
- If tuition and general fees are not paid by the due date, the school reserves the right to withdraw the student from classes until the payments are made.
- If tuition and general fees are not paid by the end of the school year, the school reserves the right to not enroll the student for the next school year.

4 - Cambridge IGCSE & A-Level Fees

- Cambridge charges fees for entry, sitting for the exam, and marking for students taking IGCSE and A-Level examinations. The student's family is responsible for these fees. Exam fees and sign-up information will be sent to families in January of each year.
